



# The School Day: 8:30am-3:30pm

- Attendance will be taken by the homeroom teacher daily at 8:30.
- Students will have "on" and "off" time throughout the day.
- "On" time is when the student will have live instruction with the teacher.
- "Off" time is when the student may be working independently, working in a small group with a teacher, or doing programs like IXL and Raz Kids.
- All students will have a lunch break from 11:30-12:30.

## **Schedules**

 Aspen will go live on August 28th. Students and parents will be able to log into Aspen to see their classes.

- 3rd 8th grade students will have two teachers: one for Math and Science and one for ELA and Social Studies.
- PK 2nd will have one teacher.
- Other support teachers will work with students throughout the day.

Have routines for your child:

- Determine a bed time
- Make sure they are up and dressed for school by 8:20
- Limit time on video games, tv, etc.

Choose a good place to learn:

- Set up your child in a quiet place where they can concentrate.
- Have your child sit at a desk or table.
- Have school supplies nearby.

Stay in communication with the teacher:

- Keep connected with the teacher through email.
- Feel free to ask to schedule a Google Meet with the teacher to discuss your child's progress.
- Activate your Parent Portal account to monitor grades.
- Ask to be a guardian on Google Classroom so you can receive emails to missing or late assignments.
- Let the teacher know if your child is struggling to stay organized or complete the work.

Ask your child questions about their day:

- What did you enjoy about your day?
- Do you have any tests or projects coming up?
- Was there anything you struggled with today?
- What did you learn about today?
- Can you show me something you did today?
